

## **MATERIALS**

Scheepjes
5 balls
Invica Everest
#98510
75% wool
25%nylon
420m/100gm ball
4.5mm (G) hook

## **NOTIONS**

Tapestry needle 8 markers

Illustrated here to fit a 12 year old using approximately 2000mts

Length from Shoulder to Hem 66cm (26")

## **Best Friend**

This magnificent swirl jacket begins life as a shrug. When it gets cold this is sure to become any girl's best friend. The sleeves are tapered for a neat fit and the waist will be enhanced with the swirl shaping

## 60 chains

CNR, 3 shells, CNR, 4 shells, CNR, 3 shells, CNR,

Work as the shrug in the video until the back reaches the magic number.

Join the underarm.

Work in pattern around the outside edge, working 5 rounds of block stitch.

Place 8 markers as evenly as

you can in the chain spaces around the outside edge beginning with one at the Centre B back neck & one in the Centre Back hem and the 3 others evenly spaced in between on either side.

**Increase round** work a CNR in each of the marked chain sp and a shell in all others. Join. Turn your work

**Next 2 rounds:** Work 1 shell in each ch sp around.

Move the 8 markers up to the corresponding chain spaces above the CNRs in the previous increase round.

Repeat the last 3rounds, until the work measures approximately 1 ¾ times the length from **neck to waist**, or the length desired.

**Sleeve** work 2 decrease rounds, [6 rounds straight, 1 decrease round] 4 times, work straight until the required length.

**Edging:** work 2 rounds of MM around the entire outside edge. 2 rounds MM on each sleeve
