

Coconut Ice

This dress has been made in classic lines for a baby to toddler with a gathered skirt and tie at the front.

72 chains

2 shells, CNR, 3 shells, CNR, 4 shells,
CNR, 3 shells, CNR, 2 shells

Using MC Work as the Sweater/Jumper in the video joining the neck at round 5.

Work in pattern until the back reaches the magic number.

Join the underarm.

Work in pattern for 3 rows

Increase frill is demonstrated in "it's all in the details" section of the video.

Work a shell in each 1 ch sp and in each middle stitch of each shell for 1 round only.

This will double the amount of shells.

Work straight in pattern for 8 ½" (21 cm)

Fasten off

Using CC work 6 rounds in pattern.

The one in the video was worn by a 4 year old Taylyn so I just added 2 rows in Cream and 5 rows MM to lengthen it. Which is the beauty of Kids Squared and growing children to make the garments wearable for longer .

Sleeve

Work 1 round with a sleeve decrease

Work 5 rounds in Block stitch using the CC for the 1st, 3rd and 5th round and MC for the shell rounds.

Edging

2 rounds MM at the neck edge in CC, make a buttonhole loop by working 5 ch, sl st into the edge in the top corner on the 2nd row.

Cording

Using CC make a chain twice as long as the chest measurement dc(sc) into each st. Fasten off. Thread through the row before the Frill and tie in a knot.

4 balls #130 Old Lace
(MC)

1 ball

#238 Powder

Pink(CC)

100% cotton

125m/50gm ball

3.5mm(E)hook

1 button

2 markers

Tapestry needle
