

MATERIALS

Scheepjes Merino Soft Brush 6 balls #252

50% Superwash Merino 25% Micro 25% Acryl 105m/50gm ball 4.5mm (G) hook

NOTIONS: 2 markers Tapestry needle

Illustrated here to fit a 5-6 year old Uses approximately 540 metres

Length from Shoulder to Hem 43cm (17 ")

Cooper's Hoodie

This pocketed vest will look great on any young man. Add the hood if desired to keep out the chills or add some sleeves. The choice is yours.

72 chains

2 shells, CNR, 3 shells, CNR, 4 shells, CNR, 3 shells, CNR, 2 shells

Work as the Sweater/Jumper in the video joining the neck at round 5. Work in pattern until you reach the magic number

Join the underarm.

Work in pattern until you reach 3 inches longer than the waist. Or the length desired.

Side splits Place a marker in the 1 ch space in this row directly below the underarms. These will mark the placement of the split opening

Work in pattern rows over the front shells only for 2". Fasten off and work the same amount of rows for the back.

The neck opening is at the front for this design

Work the hood as shown in the "it's all in the details" section of the video with a CNR in the centre back ch-1(1 ch) sp. Work in pattern until the hood is ¾ MN in length from the first row. Join with the chaining seam as seen in "it's all in the details" section of the video.

No Sleeve

Edging Work 2 rounds MM on all edges

Pockets Make 2

20 ch, work in MM stitch for 18 rows sew in place where desired as seen in the last "it's all in the details" section of the video.
