

MATERIALS

1 ball
Scheepjes
Invicta Colour #971
for the body of the
garment
75% wool
25% polyamide
420 m/ 100 gm
1 ball
Invicta Extra #1461
for the trim
75% wool
25% polyamide
210 m/ 50 gm

NOTIONS

2 markers Tapestry needle

Illustrated here to fit a 2 year old using approximately 420 metres

Length from Shoulder to Hem 33cm (13")

Ties

British: Make 50 ch, 1 dc in the 2nd ch from hook, 1 dc in each st to end.

USA: Make ch 50, sc in the 2nd ch from hook, sc in each st to end.



Cutie Pie Vest

This is true wardrobe essential. It is great for boys and girls when an extra layer is needed. It keeps the body toasty warm. The adjustable ties mean that it will grow with them.

56 chains

CNR, 3 shells, CNR, 4 shells, CNR, 3 shells, CNR,

Work as the V-necked cardigan in the video until the back is the magic number. Join the underarm.

Work increasing at the centre fronts in pattern for 5 rows

Increase row

Place a marker in the 1 ch space in this row at each underarm. Work an increase at the beginning and end of the row at the centre fronts, and work a CNR in both of the marked spaces.

Work 2 rows increasing at the centre fronts without underarm increases.

Repeat the last 3 rows twice

Work in pattern until each of the fronts are the magic number. Now work straight as in

the sweater/cardigan video until it is the desired length.

Sleeve

There is no sleeve in this design however sleeves can be added if desired.

Edging

Work 2 rounds of MM around the entire outside edge in trim colour beginning at the back neck.

Round 3: work in MM stitch unit you reach the corner at the front, Make a tie, continue working in MM st until you reach the corner at the 2nd front, Make a tie,

continue working in MM st until you reach the beginning. Join.

Make 2 more ties and attach one on the outside underarm and one on the inside underarm at the first increases. Tie a knot in the end of each tie.
