

Desert Rose Dress

MATERIALS

Scheepjes

Catona

2 balls

#518 Marshmallow

#257 Antique Mauve

#179 Topaz

#383 Ginger Gold

#388 Rust

100% cotton

125m/50gm ball

4.5mm (G)hook

1 button

NOTIONS:

2 markers

Tapestry needle

Illustrated here to fit

a 5 year old

Uses approximately

650 metres

**Length from
Shoulder to Hem**

63cm (25")

This dress has been made to suit the young modern gypsy girl who still likes some frills in her life.

72 chains

2 shells, CNR, 3 shells, CNR, 4 shells, CNR, 3 shells, CNR, 2 shells

Working with 1 colour per row for the yoke work as the Sweater/Jumper in the video joining the neck at round 5. Join the underarm.

Work in pattern in the next colour until this is twice the amount of rows to the underarm.

Change to next colour **Increase frill** is demonstrated in "Its all in the details" section of the video.

Work a shell in each 1 ch sp and in each middle stitch of the shell for 1 round only.

This will double the amount of shells. Work 3 rounds in pattern. [Change to next colour and work 4 rows]3 times.

No Sleeve

Edging Work 2 rounds MM on sleeve edge in the colour used to join underarm.

2 rounds MM at the neck edge in colour 1, make a buttonhole loop by working 5 ch, sl st into the edge in the top corner on the 2nd row.

Work 2 rounds MM on bottom edge in the colour used to finish. This style is finished with a picot edge on the neck as follows:

USA [sc into ch-1 sp, ch1, sk 1 sc, (sc, ch 3, sc into the side of the last sc worked to make the picot),]repeat around

British [1dc, in the next ch sp, 1 ch, miss 1 dc,(1 dc, 3 ch, dc into the side of the last dc worked to make the picot)] repeat around.



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
