

MATERIALS

Scheepjes

2 balls

Catona Denim #135

100% cotton

125m/50gm ball

3.5mm (E) hook

NOTIONS

Tapestry needle

1 jeans button

Illustrated here to fit
a 3 year old using
approximately
200mts

Length from Shoulder to Hem

19cm (7 ½")

Vst= 1 tr, 1 ch, 1 tr, 1 ch
all worked into the 1 st

3 dtrcluster = Work 1
dtr (2 wraps) into the
first st until there are 2
loops left on the hook,
work a 2nd dtr into the
same ch sp until there
are 3 loops left on the
hook, work a 3rd dtr
into the same st until
there are 4 loops left on
the hook, YO and
draw through all loops.

Fairy Floss

Whip this one up in 2 nights. It is the perfect decorative summer shrug. This turns any girl into a fairy princess.

60 chains

CNR, 3 shells, CNR, 4 shells, CNR, 3 shells, CNR,

Work as the shrug in the video until the back reaches the magic number.

Join the underarm. Fasten off.

Rejoin yarn at row 1 and work around the bottom edge only to the other side of row 1. You can use any lacy stitch for this.

Frill rows: these are the rows I worked in Fairy Floss in British terms *Work down the front of the shrug along the back edge then up the second front to the opposite side of Row 1*

Frill Row 1: 1 dc into the first 4 ch sp at the side of row 1, (5 tr into the next 4 ch sp, 1 dc into next 4 ch sp,) Repeat down to 1 ch sp at the underarm (5 tr into the next 1 ch sp, 1 dc into next 1 ch sp) repeat across to 1 ch sp at the underarm (5 tr into the next 4 ch sp, 1 dc into next 4 ch sp) repeat up the 2nd front to the side of row 1. Turn.

Row 2 : 4 ch, 1tr 1 ch (*counts as a Vst*) into the first dc (miss 1 st, 1 tr in the next st, 1 ch, miss 1 st, 1 tr, in the next st, 1 ch, miss 1 st, Vst into the dc) Repeat to end. Turn

Row 3: ch 3, 2 tr in 1 ch sp to end, 1 tr in the last st. Turn

Row 4: 3 ch, miss 2 st in the forward direction, 1 tr, 1 ch in the next st, 1 tr in the first of the 2 missed stitches (cross stitch formed). Repeat across. 1 tr in the last st. Turn.

Row 5: 4 ch, (3 dtr cluster in the next ch sp, 3ch). Repeat across, omitting the last 3 ch, 1 dtr in the last st. Turn.

Row 6: 1 ch, 1 dc into the first dtr (5 ch, 1 dc into next ch 3 sp) Repeat across, 1 dc in the last 4 ch sp. Turn

Round 7: ch 5, (1 dc in the next 5 ch sp, 5 ch) Repeat across to last 5 ch sp, 1 dc, 2 ch, 1 tr in the dc. Turn

Round 8: 3 ch, 2 tr in the 2 ch sp, (1 tr in next 5 ch sp, 5 tr in next 5 ch sp) Repeat across. Work 3 tr in the last 2 ch sp. Turn.

Row 9: 1 ch ([1dc, in the next st, 1 ch, miss 1 st] twice, 1 dc into the next st, 3 ch, 1 dc into the side of the last dc worked to make the picot) Repeat across.

Sleeve

3 decrease rounds and 1 round straight

Edging

2 rounds of MM st on sleeve

2 rounds MM at the neck edge. Make a buttonhole loop by working 5 ch, sl st into the edge. Fasten off.



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
