Scheepjes

Catona 2 balls each

#400 Petrol Blue

#113 Delphinium

#146 Vivid Blue

#251 Garden Rose

#253 Tropic

100% cotton

125m/50gm ball

4.5mm (G)hook

1 button

# Mermaid Miss

*This dress has been made to suit a modern pre-teen. It flares slightly at the hips so is both fun and stylish in the colours of a mermaid.*

**72 chains**

**2 shells, CNR, 3 shells, CNR, 4 shells,  
CNR, 3 shells, CNR, 2 shells**

To make the stripes look so random throughout work down the colour list until all the colours have been used then return to the top colour and keep working in the same order. [4,1,3,1,2,1] repeated throughout.

E.g.work 4 rows in the first colour, 1 row in the next colour, 3 rows in the next colour, 1 row in the next colour, 2 rows in the next colour, 1 row in the next colour

Using MC Work as the Sweater/Jumper in the video joining the neck at round 5.

Work in pattern until the back reaches the magic number.

Join the underarm.

Work in pattern for 6 rounds, work a decrease round directly below the underarm

Work 12 rounds without shaping, place a marker in the 1 ch space in this row at each underarm directly below the decreases, Work a CNR in both of the marked spaces.

Work 8 rounds, inc each side directly below the last increases, ( work 6 rounds, inc each side directly below the last increases) twice,

Work straight to end.

### Sleeve

Work 2 rounds with a sleeve decreases keeping in colour order. Work 6 rounds, dec, 4 rounds, dec, 4 rounds, dec. Work in pattern until the sleeve is  $\frac{3}{4}$  underarm length.

### Edging

**Neck Edge** 2 rounds MM in colour 1, make a buttonhole loop by working 5 ch, sl st into the edge in the top corner on the 2<sup>nd</sup> row.

**Sleeve and bottom edge** 2 rounds MM



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
