Scheepjes

1 ball

Colour Crafter #1063

Rotterdam

100% premium acrylic

300m/100gm ball

3.5mm (E) hook

1 feature button

outside and 1 button

inside

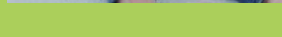

Snug-a-Bub

This tiny shrug is so cute. It will keep baby's back and neck warm with the textured ribbed trim. The feature button and tab adds fair while keeping it secure for the wrigglers. Make one in every colour.



60 chains

CNR, 3 shells, CNR, 4 shells, CNR, 3 shells, CNR,

Work as the shrug in the video until the back reaches the magic number. Join the underarm. Work around the outside edge as seen in the "It's all in the details" section of the video working 3tr(USA dc) in each 4 ch sp at front neck edges and 4 tr(USA dc) in the 3 ch spaces at the neck edge, over the foundation chains, & 1 tr in each st along the back's bottom edge.

Sleeve

Work 2 decrease rounds, work straight until the sleeve is the required length.

Edging

Work 7 rounds of rib trim around the entire outside edge as seen in "Its all in the details" of the video

Work 1 round of dc(USA sc) in each st around. Fasten off. Work 3 rounds of rib trim per sleeve

Front Tab

Attach yarn at the middle of the front Work 10 st in MM st for 14 rows. Sew the feature button on the front and a smaller button directly under it on the other side of the tab. Use the stretchiness of the stitch to button it through to the inside of the garment where it fits best.

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
