

MATERIALS

Scheepjes 2 balls Eliza #214 Gentle Apricot 1 ball #211 Lime Slice 100% polyamide 230 m/ 100 gm 2 buttons

NOTIONS

2 markers Tapestry needle Illustrated here to fit a 3 year old using approximately 400metres

Length from Shoulder to Hem 30cm (12")

Covered buttons

Row 1: Make 2 ch, 12 dc in the first chain, do not join but work the remainder of the button in a continuous spiral

Row 2: (2 dc in the next st, 1 dc in the next st) 6 times. -18 dc Row 3 &4:1 dc in each st around. Fasten off leaving a 20 cm tail. Using a tapestry needle pick up the BLO of each st in the last round. Insert the button and pull these stitches up tight and secure with a back stitch & sew in place.



Sorbet Charmer

Mix up the fruity colours of Eliza for this cardigan and you have a fun combination that will look super cute.

56 chains

CNR, 3 shells, CNR, 4 shells, CNR, 3 shells, CNR,

Work as the V-necked cardigan in the video until the fronts measure ½ your magic number.

Work straight in pattern until you reach your magic number.

Join the underarm. Work straight in pattern for 3 rows

Increase row

Place a marker in the 1 ch space

in this row at each underarm. Work a CNR in both of the marked spaces.

Work 2 rows straight in pattern without shaping.

Repeat the last 3 rows, 3 times

Work straight in pattern without shaping until you reach your required length.

Sleeve

Using Gentle apricot work 2 decrease rounds then work straight for 6 rounds, decrease round, Work until the sleeve is the required length.

Work the 2nd sleeve in the same way but work (2 rounds Lime Slice and 1 round in Gentle Apricot) repeated to end.

Edging

Using Lime Slice Work 2 rounds of MM around the entire outside edge beginning at the back neck.

Round 3: work in MM stitch unit you reach the corner at the right front, 3 ch for a buttonhole, miss 3 st, continue working in MM st until you reach the beginning. Join.

Round 4&5: work in MM all around.

Sleeve edging Using Lime Slice Work 5 rounds of MM around the apricot sleeve and 5 rounds of MM st in the opposite colour than the last row worked in the stripy sleeve.

Pocket (as seen in "Its all in the details" section of the video)

18 ch, work in MM stitch for 14 rows sew in place on the front opposite the striped sleeve.
