MATERIALS

Scheepjes

2 balls Stardust

#654

11% Mohair

11% wool

75% premium acrylic

3% metallic

540m/100gm ball

4.5mm (G) hook

5 buttons

NOTIONS

2 markers

Tapestry needle

Illustrated here to fit
a 10 year old

Uses approximately
1080 metres

**Length from
Shoulder to Hem**

79cm (31")

This long duster cardigan has just the right amount of sparkle to make a girl feel cozy and slightly magical at the same time.

72 chains

2 shells, CNR, 3 shells, CNR, 4 shells, CNR, 3 shells, CNR, 2 shells



Work as the sweater/Jumper in the video but do not join at the neck.

Work in pattern until the back reaches the magic number.

Join the underarm.

(Work in pattern for 4 rows, work a decrease row directly below the underarm on each side) twice

Work 5 rows without shaping, place a marker in the 1 ch space in this row at each underarm directly below the decreases, Work a CNR in both of the marked spaces.

Repeat the last 6 rows until the length desired.

Sleeve

Work in pattern decreasing as in the video for 4 rows, work 6 rows straight in pattern without shaping, work a dec row, and work straight until the sleeve is the length required.

Edging

Work 2 rounds of MM stitch around the outside opening. On the 3rd round work 5 button holes evenly on the left front edge

Work 2 more rounds of MM. On round 5 work a picot as follows:

USA [sc into ch-1 sp, ch1, sk 1 sc, (sc, ch 3, sc into the side of the last sc worked to make the picot),]repeat around

British [1dc, in the next ch sp, 1 ch, miss 1 dc,(1 dc, 3 ch, dc into the side of the last dc worked to make the picot)] repeat around.

3 rounds MM on the sleeves.

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
